Pivot: Assignments

Core Group Discussion Guide 03-25-2018

Message Overview:

This morning's message is about hearing God's voice...and saying yes. Ephesians 2:10 tells us that God gives his people assignments and our work is to be faithful and trust him in obedience. We will be drawing from the Old Testament story of Moses to help us understand frequent patterns in God's call on our lives. This is the last message in our Pivot series. Understanding that God has designed us for specific tasks and learning to understand and live in those assignments is key to following Jesus. I hope your discussion is lively and spiritually enriching!

- Story of Moses
- Ephesians 2:10
- Proverbs 16:9
- I Corinthians 7

Questions for Discussion:

- I. What questions or thoughts did you come away with this morning?
- We want to spend some time talking about finding and living in God's assignments for us.
 - 2. In the message, we were reminded that the Scriptures give us many concrete instructions about following Jesus. Create a list of 10 things we know for sure that God has called us too as his people.
 - 3. Read I Corinthians 7 together.
 - a. Part of God's assignment for our lives comes from the situations he has placed us in. What are those things for you?
 - b. From the verses we read, which of these instructions might be most difficult to accept?
 - c. Are there difficult areas of your life that you have wondered how God wants to use you?
 - d. Why do you think God wants us to persevere?
 - e. How do you know when its time to move on from that situation?
 - 4. In the message, we were reminded that often God uses difficult situations to prepare us for new assignments. Have you ever experienced that?
 - 5. Did anyone feel God speak to them about a new assignment in a way that they would like to share and invite prayer for?
