This Sunday ends our R12 Markers series. Verse 13 of Romans 12 lists two very simple descriptions of genuine love. Generosity and kindness to strangers both stem from a heart centered on Christ and filled by his love. It is my hope that the message this morning stirs us toward greater kindness toward each other and to the strangers seeking our help.

Questions for Discussion:

1. Before discussing anything, invite each person to write down five things God has blessed them with. (These can be absolutely anything that is viewed as a gift from God: spiritual, financial, occupational, or people in our lives.)
2. Take some time to discuss with your group how these gifts from God can help meet the needs of your family, the church, your CORE Group, and others God has placed on your path of life.
 In your answer remember all different kinds of needs: spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical.
3. For whom could you, your family, or your CORE Group provide the love that only hospitality can provide?
4. What practical steps must you take to make this an accomplished reality?
