Discussion Guide for January 27, 2019

Message Overview:

Have you ever felt like you're putting on a show? Like the person people think you are doesn't line up with the person you really are. Or maybe you've been known to put on different personas for different situation, personas that help you fit in with certain crowds, even if that persona doesn't reflect who you really want to be. We can all relate because we all struggle with the same big questions. Who am I? Who loves me? Why am I here? We can answer these questions by looking into scripture to see what God has to say about us.
